As the first winery in China, Changyu Pioneer was founded in 1892 by Zhang Bishi, an overseas Chinese diplomat. He decided to start his pioneering winery in Yantai and named it “Zhang Yu Wine Company”. He imported more than 500,000 vine plants from the United States and Europe and thus paved the way for modern Chinese wine production, with the support of an Austrian winegrower: Baron von Babo.

After more than 120 years of growth, its portfolio includes wines, brandy, sparkling wines and healthy liqueurs and is well received in more than 20 countries. Changyu is also the largest producer of Chinese wine in the country, with a high market share nationwide. The Ningxia region is located approximately 1,330 kilometers west of Beijing. It is located in central western China, on the periphery...
